






Juneau is the capital city of Alaska, located in the southeastern part of the state. It's a unique city because it is one of the few state capitals in the U.S. that cannot be accessed by road. It is only reachable by boat or plane, which adds to its charm and remoteness. After arriving at Juneau International Airport, you will be greeted by Captain Liam and Bosun Dan.

Once all guests are onboard and the safety meeting has been completed, Unbridled will start the passage to Tracey Arm, heading south through Stevens passage. Once at anchor keep an eye out for bald eagles and hopefully some hungry brown bears searching for salmon.

Tracy Arm Fjord

The Tracy Arm fjord is accessible only by boat or seaplane. It is a wonderful place to visit and should be included in any charter in the region. It is a place to view some marvels of nature from the water, surrounded by mountain peaks and waterfalls. Apart from the two glaciers, North and South Sawyer which are major spectacles themselves, you will see much land and marine life. On land you will probably see bears, wolves, deer and goats. Because the ice interferes with whales' communication, it is a good spot for seals to have their pups. Above these spectacles you will see majestic eagles and other minor birdlife flying around. The glacier is live, in that it is flowing and "calving" or losing pieces of ice into the water. You will enjoy the stillness and the sounds of the ice if the boat's engines are turned off. A loud and memorable crash normally accompanies larger pieces of ice hitting the water. In the water and on the ice flows you may see whales, orcas and seals of various sizes.

Tracy Arm Fjord - Mole Harbour



Once dinner has been caught we will make our way to Mole Harbor. Mole Harbor is a small, secluded bay or inlet located on the coast of Alaska. It boasts a quiet, secluded anchorage with an abundant of wildlife such as whales, seals and sea otters.



Red Bluff Bay - Baranof Falls





Just a short passage up the coast lies Baranof Falls. The perfect place to unwind, this area is outstanding natural bliss - boasting no less than nine warm silky hot spring pools beneath a long veiling horsetail waterfall. The raging Baranof River pulses through and the surrounding rocks and trees create a stunning backdrop and shelter from the sun. To the edge of the steamy pools, you will also find a natural coldwater plunge - perfect for a refreshing dip after soaking tired muscles. There's also a public bathhouse and hiking trails close by to truly immerse you in the full Alaskan wilderness experience.

Once you're awake, we'll start the engines and head toward Pavlov Harbor. While underway, enjoy a hot breakfast prepared by our amazing chef, Calvin.

Pavlov Harbor is a perfect spot for charter guests to catch sight of grizzlies. North on Alaska's Chatham Strait and sitting inside Freshwater Bay you will find the anchorage of Pavlov Harbor. Flanked by rising mountains and mist, this is prime bear viewing territory. In this spot, you can see bears fishing for salmon in the thundering river. Boat trips to get to a safe distance for bear viewing are available via tender or kayaking.
